



# Cyclone Idai Appeal



Please help those affected by Cyclone Idai in Zimbabwe and Malawi.



An estimated 2.6 million people have been affected by Cyclone Idai in Mozambique, Malawi and Zimbabwe. At least 480 people have been killed and an estimated 400,000 have lost their homes.

These devastating tolls are set to rise in the coming days once the full extent of the damage becomes clearer.

Those affected – especially those in remote areas – are in desperate need of food, water, clothing, shelter and medicine.

Christian Aid is working as part of the Disasters Emergency Committee to raise urgent funds. Working with our local partners on the ground in Zimbabwe and Malawi, we are helping to provide much-needed emergency assistance.

Our partners are on the ground in Zimbabwe and Malawi, assessing the impact of Cyclone Idai and responding to people's needs.

We are working through local partners Eagles Relief and Development in Chikwawa District in Malawi, and Apostolic Women's Empowerment Trust (AWET), Anglican Relief and Development in Zimbabwe (ARDEZ) and Padare in Zimbabwe.

Together we are working to provide food, shelter, clothing, water, healthcare, sanitation, hygiene and psycho-social support services.

We are also focused on the specific needs of vulnerable groups including children, women, those with disabilities, and the elderly.
